The event was hosted at Illuminate Event Venue, JAFCO's unique event space that offers employment opportunities for young adults with autism. Revenue from the venue directly supports the Children's Ability Center programs and services.

The **JAFCO Children's Ability Center** serves children from birth to age 22 who have been diagnosed with a developmental disability and their families. The campus also has three respite homes where children can stay overnight, providing families with peace of mind and valuable respite while their children build friendships, develop new skills and gain independence.

The lives of more than 7,000 children and families in the community have been touched since the JAFCO Children's Ability Center opened its doors 10 years ago.
